RESOLUTION NO. 2022-23 003

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SACRAMENTO VALLEY CHARTER SCHOOL PROCLAIMING A LOCAL EMERGENCY, RATIFYING THE PROCLAMATION OF A STATE OF EMERGENCY BY GORVERNOR GAVIN NEWSOM DATED MARCH 4, 2020, AND AUTHORIZING REMOTE TELECONFERENCE MEETINGS OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF SACRAMENTO VALLEY CHARTER SCHOOL PURSUANT TO BROWN ACT PROVISIONS. THE SCHOOL BOARD IS REQUIRED TO TAKE ACTION TO EXTEND THE LOCAL EMERGENCY NOT TO EXCEED 30-DAY PERIODS. THE ABILITY TO ADOPT REOSLUTIONS TO SUSPEND THE SPECIFIC BROWN ACT PROVISIONS RELATING TO TELECONFERENCING EXPIRES ON JANUARY I, 2024.

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Valley Chmter School is committed to preserving and nurturing public access and participation in meetings of the Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, all meetings of Sacramento Valley Charter School's governing body me open and public, as required by the Ralph M. Brown Act (Cal. Gov. Code 54950-54963), so that any member of the public may attend, participate, and watch the School's governing body conduct its business; and

WHEREAS, the Brown Act, Government Code section 54953(e), makes provisions for remote teleconferencing participation in meetings by members of a governing body, without compliance with the requirements of Government Code section 54953(b)(3), subject to the existence of certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, a required condition is that a state of emergency is declared by the Governor pursuant to Government Code section 8625, proclaiming the existence of conditions of disaster or of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the State caused by conditions as described in Government Code section 8558; and

WHEREAS, a proclamation is made when there is an actual incident, threat of disaster, or extreme petil to the safety of persons and property within the jntisdictions that are within the School's boundaries, caused by natural, technological, or human-caused disasters; and

WHEREAS, it is further required that state or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing, or, the legislative body meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health and safety of attendees; and

WHEREAS, such conditions exist in the School's areas of attendance, specifically, the Governor's March 4, 2020 declaration of a State of Emergency for COVID-19; and,

WHEREAS, Yolo County and Sacramento County have issued continuing and revised health orders in July 2021 regarding wearing masks in all public indoor settings regardless of vaccination status,

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors does hereby find that COVID-19, its variants and masking orders and recommendation, and similar conditions may cause imminent tisk to participants, has caused, and will continue to cause, conditions of peril to the safety of persons within the School that are likely to be beyond the control of services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of the School, and desires to proclaim a local emergency and ratify the proclamation of state of emergency by the Governor of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, as a consequence of the local emergency, the Board of Directors does hereby find that the governing body of Sacramento Valley Chatter School shall conduct their meetings without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of Government Code section 54953, as authorized by subdivision (e) of section 54953, and that such legislative bodies shall comply with the requirements to provide the public with access to the meetings as prescribed in paragraph (2) of subdivision (e) of section 54953; and

WHEREAS, SACRAMENTO VALLEY CHARTER SCHOOL HAS TAKEN AND CONTINUES TO TAKE MEASURES FOR PUBLIC PARTICIPATION THROUGH ZOOM LINKS AND A TELECONFERENCING OPTION FOR MAXIMUM INCLUSION OF THE PUBLIC.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SACRAMENTO VALLEY CHARTER SCHOOL DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. <u>Recitals</u>. The Recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.

Section 2. <u>Proclamation of Local Emergency</u>. The Board hereby proclaims that a local emergency now exists throughout the area served by the School, and due to the age of many of the Board Members, Staff, and public participants as well as the infection rate of students, staff and the public - regardless of vaccination stains - poses imminent risk of the spread of COVID-19 and its variants.

Section 3. <u>Ratification of Governor's Proclamation of a State of Emergency</u>. The Board hereby ratifies the Governor of the State of California's Proclamation of State of Emergency, effective as of its issuance date of March 4, 2020 and the local orders from July 2021 that are in the process of being revised, rescinded or not extended or renewed.

Section 4. <u>Remote Teleconference Meetings</u>. The staff and governing body of Sacramento Valley Chatter School are hereby authorized and directed to take all actions necessaly to carry out the intent and purpose of this Resolution including, conducting open and public meetings in accordance with Government Code section 54953(e) and other applicable provisions of the Brown Act.

Section 5. <u>Effective Date of Resolution</u>. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and shall be effective until the earlier of October 17, 2022, or such time the Board of Directors adopts a subsequent resolution in accordance with Government Code section 54953(e)(3) to extend the time during which the governing body of Sacramento Valley Chaiter School may continue to teleconference without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of section 54953,

First Award Asse1nbly, 2022-2023: The Award Assembly was divided into 3 events to manage the number of classes and students. Teachers picked two Scholars of the Month Awards and one Teacher's Choice Award for each class. Many parents joined in the ceremony. Parents were addressed about the importance of their partnership and success of their scholars. They were also impressed upon not to plan a vacation during the school year requesting for Independent Study. PE Coach and aids participated in the ceremony.

Visit of WUSD Superintendent in School: Dr. Chaiyl Hildreth is visiting our school tomorrow from 9:00am -10:00am.

Conflict of Interest Code: A special 1neeting is needed to be compliant with Yolo County's requirement.

New Van Put on Route: The new Van has been put on West Sac route with 10 students. Attendance Improvement: The current enrollment is 305. Our attendance has improved some days over 96%.

Staff Update: We are still not able to hire a P.E. teacher, However, SWEAT Team coaches are meeting physical fitness needs of the middle school and of the elementaiy. We are still looking for a speech pathologist. A new four-day substitute teacher has been

hired for meeting daily needs, Donald Steele for \$280 per day. Nirmal Kaur, a substitute for cafeteria hired to cover the staff on leave. A need of full-time special education teachers is required to address all needs of this department. Vice principal Lisa Pino's last day in school was September 13, 2022.

Automation of key doors completed: The control of the front office door is now in the office. We are still working with the locksmith to address a few problems.

Security Guard Need: To avoid untoward incident, we are feeling a greater need of an armed security guard.

Interim CAASPP Assessments will take place fr01n September 26 that will give teachers a date of students' learning profile. All other assessments for K-2nd are starting next week.
