These may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Small magnets (refrigerator magnets will usually work, but you may want to get a few stronger small magnets)</li> <li>• Paper towels, cotton balls, plastic spoons, paper plates</li> <li>• Drinking straws (plastic)</li> <li>• Small* toy cars (1 or 2) (The size they can hold in their hands)</li> <li>• Small toy balls (two different sizes) or golf ball</li> <li>• Cornstarch and cooking oil</li> <li>• Scotch Tape, and/ or masking tape</li> <li>• Measuring cups/spoons</li> <li>• This list is not exhaustive, but you may want to check what you have at home (if you don't have magnets, maybe get those now).</li> <li>• Yardstick or measuring tape (that can go longer than a foot)</li> <li>• Save a few empty paper towel rolls, toilet paper rolls, Kleenex, shoe or cereal boxes.</li> <li>• A flashlight</li> <li>• Balloons (small package, regular party balloons)</li> </ul> <p>Optional items (You don't have to have these, but you may want to have them):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Thin Dry erase markers (four pack is fine)</li> <li>• Small dry erase eraser OR t-shirt, socks, or other soft cloth for erasing white boards</li> <li>• Small dry erase board</li> <li>• Notebook (½ inch to 1 inch) for keeping loose leaf papers in</li> <li>• Base ten blocks or blocks that can be connected to each other easily (all same size)</li> </ul> |
