Office Availability

Meet-and-Greet: Our annual meet and greet is scheduled for August 16th, 2023, from 2PM-5:30PM. Parents, families, and students are invited to attend and meet their teachers and other staff members. This time is set aside so we can all become acquainted with one another and acquire first-hand knowledge about curriculum, homework, and assignments ahead of time.

The Transportation Orientation took place on July 25th and July 26th, but we still need to finalize all transportation routes and services. All parents and guardians are required to come to the SVCS Main Office and complete the necessary paperwork by the deadline of Monday, August 7th. Transportation services can only be guaranteed to those who complete the paperwork by the deadline. We only accept Cash and Checks. Thank you for helping us make this process as smooth as possible for everyone involved!



- 1. Parents should arrive at their scheduled bus stop 10 minutes early.
- 2. Before calling our office check the **BUSWHERE** app to see the location of the bus. Information on installing **BUSWHERE** can be found on the LAST PAGE of this newsletter.
- 3. Follow all transportation safety guidelines outlined in our procedures and policies while picking-up and dropping-off.
- 4. If you plan to alternatively pick-up your student from the school you must inform the office an hour in advance.
- 5. There is a zero tolerance policy for bullying on buses/vans. Every student deserves to feel safe while riding the bus/van.



Items not allowed on campus or buses: Please be sure your students are not bringing any of the following items to school with them. We are not responsible for any lost/stolen items, if your scholar is seen with these items they will be confiscated immediately and you will be required to pick them up from the front office. These items distract students and create unnecessary competition between peers. Be sure to read through the Parent and Student Handbooks for a detailed look at rules and expectations for students.

Updated Contact Information:

For safety reasons it is extremely important that you provide updated contact information to our office. This includes email, phone numbers and any alternative communication. In case of emergency the office should be able to reach you at these contacts on the first attempt. You may also want to include the office phone number in your contacts so that you are aware that our office is calling.

School Uniform:

All scholars must be dressed in appropriate uniform attire daily. Clothing with logos and writing are not allowed at any time so prepare accordingly. Students will be sent home or asked to change if they are out of dress code and jewelry will be confiscated. This dress code will be enforced more strictly than last year so be aware of your scholars clothing choices before you send them to school each morning. Remember to write your scholar's name on all clothing and jackets!

Spirit Day:



Physical Education Update:

We are welcoming back to SVCS the **SWEAT coaches** who will be on campus for middle school and elementary PE! Physical Education is extremely important to us and the knowledge and experiences that our coaches have will help make us much stronger.





Independent Study: We discourage parents from planning trips and enrolling their students in independent study during the school year. Missing crucial concepts and lessons can affect students performance and success. Please do not plan a trip where your scholar will be missing an exceptional amount of time at the expense of their testing scores and promotion to the next grade. **If you do need to request a short independent study for your child please follow these steps:**

- 1. Call and inform our office at least 3 weeks in advance
- 2. Provide written notice of the request to the office and teacher (Written notice is not a formal contract and does not guarantee approval)
- 3. Schedule a meeting with the Principal when you can talk through plans and discuss the consequences of an extended vacation.
- 4. Submit and sign a final contract (if approved) to the office.

Step 2: Click the registration link in the email. (Do not share this link or email with others). Fill out all required information and select your correct bus stop for AM and PM options. Select the green register button.


