

3rd GRADE Supply List

Third grade supplies (does not include Punjabi needs-Please check with Punjabi teachers!)

- Headphones (plug in, no wi-fi)
- 2 wide ruled composition books (80 pages at least, 9.75 in. x 7.5 in). Two different colors. *NOTE: These are NOT for Punjabi!
- We will be covering one of these, so please get the inexpensive comp books (no plastic covers needed).

- Soft zipper pouch OR small case (NO larger than 8" x3") that can hold white board markers, highlighters, 1 glue stick, 1 eraser and 2 pencils
- 1 ream of wide ruled notebook paper
- 2 glue sticks
- 2x2 Post It Notes (3 or 4 pack)
- 3 different colored highlighters (lighter colors work best-yellow,pink,green)
- Thin (Skinny ones) Dry erase markers (four pack is fine)
- Small box (8-12 count) colored pencils
- 1 red or blue ink pen
- 1 small box of crayons (NO more than 24 count)
- 2 boxes of #2 pencils with erasers (these will be collected for class use)
- 2 erasers (not pencil toppers)
- Water bottle with lid that closes
- \$5.00 CASH for folders we will buy

- Optional: small (2 x 2) dry board eraser (I have cloth you may use instead)
