Dear Parents,

The school year, 2019-20, is closing in three days. We couldn't hold many ceremonies that celebrate the achievements of our scholars. However, we are trying to fill the gap by holding most of the events virtually. The most noted events of the year have been the Kindergarten and 8th grade graduation ceremonies. Due to COVID-19, Kindergarten is now attending a Zoom Awards Assembly along with other scholars on June 2nd. We had to delay our 8th grade graduation to June 17th, due to the pandemic. Many of our graduating 8th grade scholars were admitted to Kindergarten in 2011 when SVCS opened for the first time. Their entire education took place in SVCS, and it is the first time that they will go to another school for their secondary education.

Thank you to all SVCS parents and families for cooperating with us after COVID-19 forced us to close school abruptly. The transition to the Online School occurred swiftly and that is why SVCS has more weeks of online education than other schools. Our effort is to engage our scholars in learning despite the many hurdles on the way due to the Novel Coronavirus disrupting our normal life. We have created a Parents' Survey on our website. In order to continue the learning experience of our scholars, we have planned an Online Summer School, June 22nd - July 17th, 2020. I acknowledge that we are passing through a very difficult phase in history and the times are extremely challenging. We look forward to strengthening our partnership so that together we can find solutions to the learning needs of our scholars. 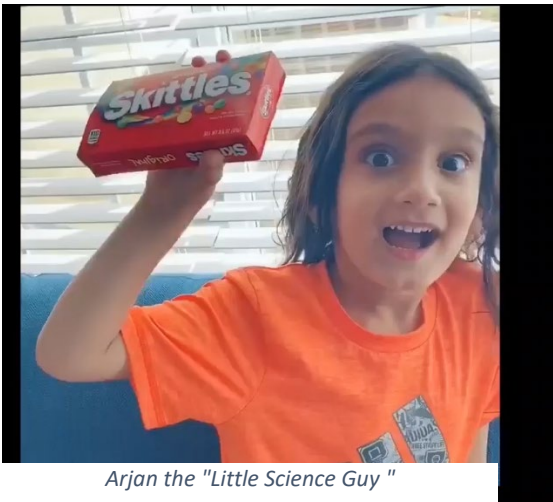

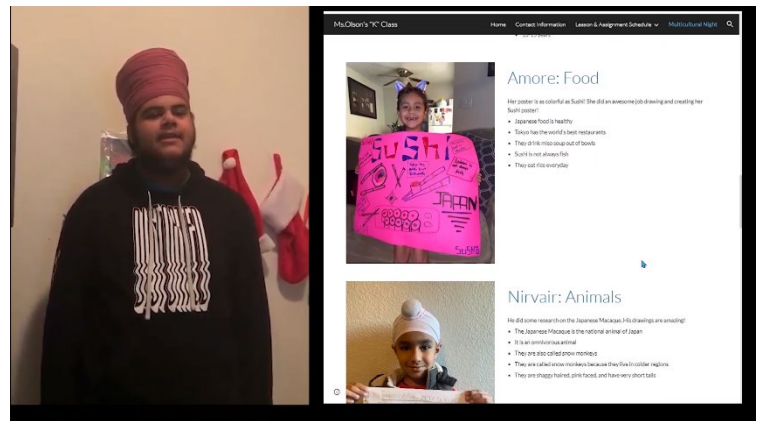
