

Talent Show Guidelines

Talent shows guidelines often include rules about content, length, and participation. They may also include expectations for backstage behavior and how to prepare for the show.

Content

- No Profanity, vulgarity, or sexually explicit content
- No risqué costuming
- No copyrighted images, videos, or sounds
- No dangerous stunts
- In all cases, decisions of the judges are final and will not be open to discussion.

Length

- Recommended act length is 3 minutes, with a maximum of 5 minutes
- Setup time should be minimal.

Participation

- Each person can only enter one performance
- Acts may include singing, spoken words, dance, or a combination of talents.
- Students who are part of a group act should submit their participation forms together.

Preparation

- Submit lyrics or scripts for singing or spoken word performances
- Submit music tracks for final approval
- Have a clear story to connect with the audience
- Acts are responsible for their own props and costumes
